

Directions to Exploring New Horizons Sempervirens Site

Before giving the bus company the address, make sure that they know the following things as there is only one route to camp for buses:

- The camp is called The Salvation Army Redwood Glen Camp & Conference Center, but there are 2 locations with the name Redwood Glen, so do not just share the location name with the bus company as they might take you 1 ½ hours away to a different site in Loma Mar!
- 2. Busses must take the Granite Creek Road Exit and the directions below off of Highway 17, if a driver uses their own GPS they will go down a narrow road buses cannot go down.
 - a. Do not take the route through Mt. Hermon Road and Scotts Valley Drive in Scott Valley (the road is too narrow)
 - b. Do not take the Glenwood Road Cutoff exit off of Highway 17.

Exploring New Horizons (ENH) Sempervirens site is at **3100 Bean Creek Road in Scotts Valley, CA, 95066**.

Directions are as follows:

- -Highway 17 South
- -Exit 5 for Scotts Valley Drive toward Granite Creek Road
- -Continue straight onto Glenwood Dr. for 1.9 miles (you will see the first blue and red Redwood Glen sign)
- -Turn left onto Bean Creek Road (you will see another red and blue Redwood Glen sign). Keep an eye out for a steep hill as you don't want to miss this turn.
- -The camp is on the left .8 miles down Bean Creek Road
